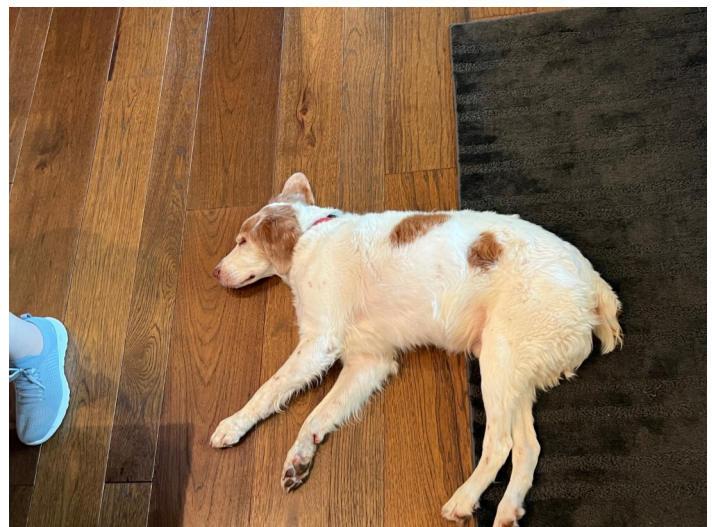

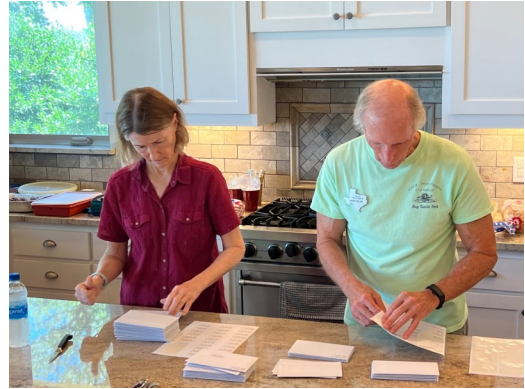

July Meeting

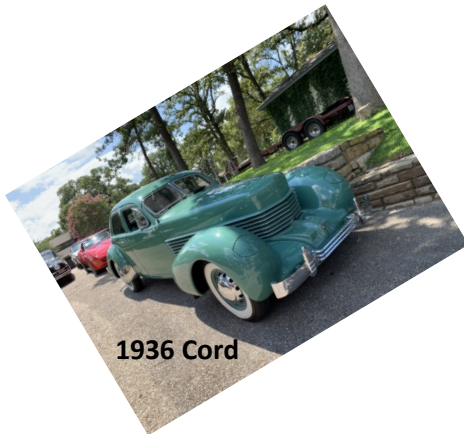
Sunday, July 17th at 2:00

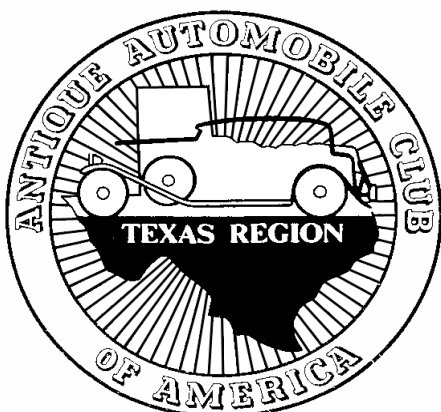
